Course design

- ▶ Duration: One-year residential program
- ▶ 5 months Campus training
 - ▶Unit1: Life of Gandhi (Mahatma in Making)
 - > Unit2: Gandhi in Action (Conflict Resolution)
 - ▶Unit3: Understanding Sustainable Development
 - ▶Unit4: Initiatives towards Sustainable Development
 - ▶ Unit5: Strategy Constructive Programme
- ▶ 4 months Field placement in villages
 - »Team building through fieldwork
- ▶ 1 month Internship with Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) / Development organisation
 - »Learning-by-doing: Planning and implementation
- ▶ 1 month Examinations and submission of dissertation
